



Shattered Rock Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

Tasting Notes:

The 2007 Cab is an elegant wine with more structure than our previous vintage – 2007 has been a growing season we will not easily forget as “the driest” ever!

Deep red with a cherry like hue. Lifted aromas of dark berry and marzipan, complexed with cedary oak. The palate is soft and generous with rich dark berry fruits, well balanced oak with velvety tannins on the finish.

We recommend it to well flavoured meat dishes or a mature hard cheese.

21 months oak matured.

Drink now to eight years.

Tasting Notes:

Generosity and warmth are the attributes the warmer year 2006 has added to this proud substantial cabernet.

Loads of intense flavours, a wave of very varietal cassis, dark berries and black cherries, leafy notes and anise combine with plums and more robust dark chocolate, mocca and tarry flavours. A complex delight with a long and lingering finish, to which the fine grained tannins contribute.

We recommend this wonderful cabernet with elegant and classical meat dishes, or with a mature cheese.

22 months in French oak.

The wine starts drinking well between two and three years and will cellar for up to 10 years.

It has the characteristic aroma of cassis with leafy overtones, the palate is firm with succulent ripe soft black fruits and cassis, plums and dark chocolate, anise and tarry flavours with a firm, controlled, varietal and fine grained tannic finish.
