Tasting Notes:

Generosity and warmth are the attributes the warmer year 2006 has added to this proud substantial cabernet. Loads of intense flavours, a wave of very varietal cassis, dark berries and black cherries, leafy notes and anise combine with plums and more robust dark chocolate, mocca and tarry flavours. A complex delight with a long and lingering finish, to which the fine grained tannins contribute.

We recommend this wonderful cabernet with elegant and classical meat dishes, or with a mature cheese.

The wine starts drinking well between two and three years and will cellar for up to 10 years.
